**Reason:** The Association is now governed by the new Incorporated Societies Act 2022. It requires the Association to re-register under the Act by April 2026. The Executive Committee has decided to take the opportunity presented by the Annual General Meeting to hold a Special General Meeting immediately following the conclusion of the Annual General Meeting to adopt rules for the Association which are in compliance with the new Act and to approve the re-registration of the Association under the Act.

The existing rules of the Association only required minor changes. These are summarised in the comparison of the Rules with the Act and by reference to the accompanying revised Rules available on the Association's website [www.businessET.org.nz/event/2024-agm](http://www.businessET.org.nz/event/2024-agm). The opportunity has also been taken to tidy up some typographical and other minor matters. The changes are indicated in the marked-up copy but a clean copy will be filed with the Registrar of Incorporated Societies.
